RULES

The Series will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, valid at the start of the series. The RYA Prescriptions will apply.

FLEETS

Boats will race in four Fleets:

- Smaller Dinghy Fleet – for Toppers, Optimists, Picos, Cadets & Mirrors
- Laser Fleet (incl. Full rig, Radials & 4.7's)
- Larger Dinghy Fleet – all other dinghy classes
- Multihull Fleet

All Dinghy Fleets will race under the PY handicap system, as per RYA's YR2/07.
The Multihull Fleet will race under the SCHRS.

SCHEDULE

The Series will be run in two parts:

Part 1 will run from Sun 7th October until 16th December 2007, with 11 races.

Part 2 will run from Sun 3rd February until 13th April 2008, with 11 races.

The scheduled time for the first warning signal each race day is 14:24.

COURSES

Courses will be set around BYC dinghy marks in Ballyholme Bay, with either a committee boat start or a shore-based start.

SCORING AND PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for each Part of the Series, in addition to the Overall Series.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the series entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the series of races.

INSURANCE / SAFETY

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2 million. In amendment of RRS 1.2 & 40, all sailors shall wear either a wet-suit or a dry-suit and in addition, adequate personal buoyancy at all times when afloat.
